

Critical Components

Critical Features/Components

An essential part, material, subassembly, system, software, or accessory of a product that has a direct bearing on the product's conformance to applicable requirements of the product standard.

Supporting technical document **like**, third party certificate, information about "Product directory" file reference, Conditions of Acceptability and technical specification/data sheet is part of the ETL Listing process. The documents to be provided to engineering and may need to be available during follow up inspection.

Listed Component

A component part, which has been previously Listed or Certified by an accredited Certification Organization with no restrictions and is used in the intended application within its ratings

Recognized Component

A component part, which has been previously evaluated by an accredited certification body with restrictions and must be evaluated as part of the basic product considering the restrictions as specified by the Conditions of Acceptability

Unlisted Component

A part that has not been previously evaluated to the appropriate designated component standard. It may also be a Listed or Recognized component that is being used outside of its evaluated Listing or component recognition.

Unlisted Components are uncontrolled, and they do not fall under a third party follow up program, Intertek may require these components to be tested and/or evaluated at least once annually, more often for certain components, as part of the independent certification process. The Unlisted Components in Section 5.0 (CDR) require testing and/or evaluation as indicated.

The Applicant will be notified, in writing, via the applicable contact methods, as defined in Section 1.0 (CDR), when these components must be selected and sent to Component Evaluation Center (CEC) for re-evaluation

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
